Le Corbusier planned the "Gesamtkunstwerk" by Lake Zurich as exhibition space for his artistic works: from oil paintings to drawings through to furniture and sculptures.

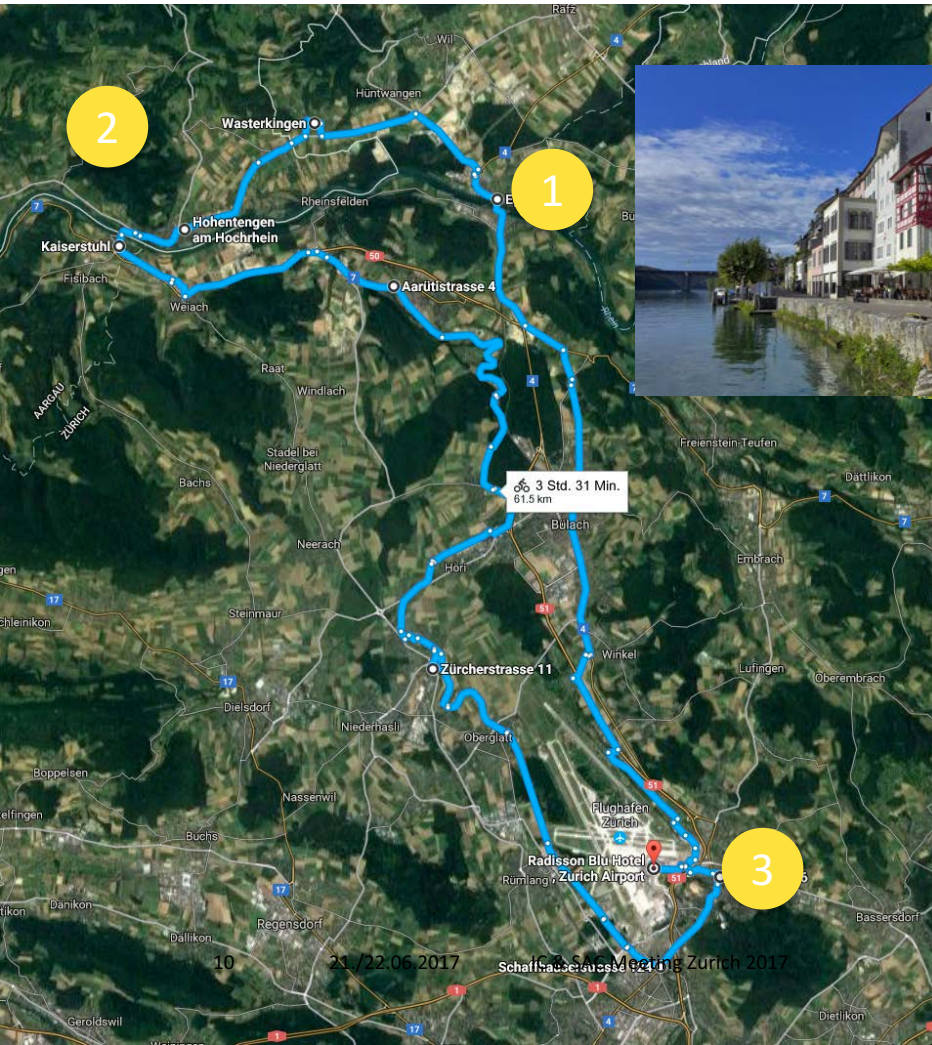


The capital city of Switzerland – **Bern**
